

What you can recycle at the Community Recycle Center

NEWSPAPER

If it comes with the newspaper, you can recycle it with newspaper.

MIXED OFFICE PAPER

White and colored copy paper, computer paper, ledger paper, notebook paper, business forms, bills, stationery, envelopes, Post-its, and non-glossy junk mail, pamphlets and brochures. Please no magazines, catalogs, newspaper, stickers, folders, binders, carbons, plastic-coated paper, plastic or metal bindings.

ALUMINUM CANS

Please empty liquid, dirt or other debris. Put aluminum foil in the steel/tin bin.

STEEL/TIN CANS

Please remove labels, rinse cans, and put or fold loose end inside can and flatten. (Loose ends cause problems and should be avoided if possible.) Aluminum foil may be placed in the same bin as steel/tin cans.

GLASS*

Please rinse, remove caps and collars and separate by color (brown, green or clear).

***Please note: According to operators of the recycling center, the Grand County Solid Waste Special Service District, glass may be used as landfill cover.** According to the District web site, "On a temporary basis, glass may be crushed and used in intermediate cover or incorporated into roads at the Moab Landfill. This practice saves the District the cost of buying cover soil." RIGID PLASTIC

#1 PETE transparent/clear plastic (eg soda & water bottles, food containers)

Please put *opaque* #1 plastic in the #3-#7 plastic bin.

#2 HDPE natural/fogged plastic (eg milk & water jugs)

#2 HDPE opaque colored plastic (eg shampoo & laundry detergent containers)

#3 through #7 plastics (eg other food & household containers, biodegradable & compostable containers; #1 opaque plastics should also go in the #3-7 bin)

Please remove all caps. Please note all plastic must be rigid. The center cannot accept plastic bags, wraps or films, even if they have a recycling symbol on them.

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

Please flatten boxes and remove packing materials. No cereal box material, or waxed or plastic-coated boxes. Boxes that merely have a shiny surface and/or colored logo design are okay.

STYROFOAM

The center has no market for styrofoam, but lets a local citizen collect it for personal use. Clean pieces large enough not to blow out of the cages only please. No peanuts, but you can take peanuts to the Canyonlands Copy Center (259-8432) or Sore No More (259-5931) for reuse.

PALLETS

The center accepts wooden pallets in good condition for reuse on center grounds. If you have damaged pallets, you can check if Triassic Industries (259-4912) or Bob's Transfer Station (259-7585) wants them.
